## **Who We Are**

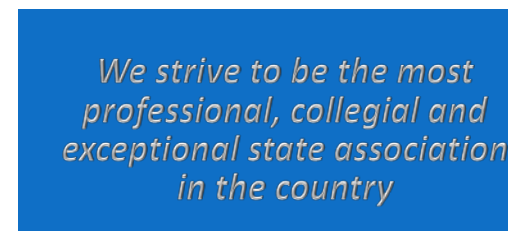

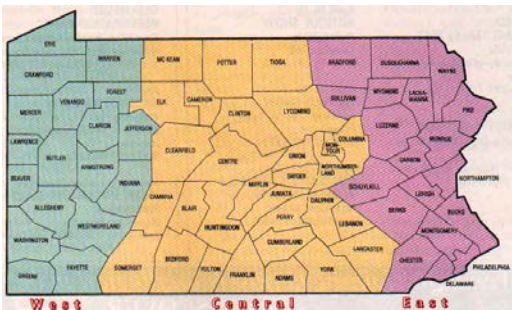


### ***Pennsylvania Judicial Center***

### ***PACM Accomplishments***

- Recognition by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania as a professional organization of court managers
